Hartlebury station opened on 1 May 1852 on the Oxford, Worcester and Wolverhampton Railway.

It became a junction in 1862 for the Severn Valley and Wyre Forest lines to Stourport-on-Severn, Bewdley, Bridgnorth, Ironbridge, Shrewsbury, Tenbury Wells and Woofferton Junction on the Welsh Marches line. It was another 20 years before a second link to the main line, at Kidderminster, was opened.

Bewdley to Woofferton Junction closed to passengers on 1 August 1962, Bridgnorth to Shrewsbury in 1963, and the line via Stourport-on-Severn to Bewdley on 3 January 1970.
